REGISTRATION

All youth should be enrolled, approved and paid 4-H members on 4-H Connect, and should be participants of their county 4-H shooting sports project. Contestant entry will be made via 4-H Connect under the title, "2020 D6 4-H Rifle Contest", during the timeframe of **March 2 - 16**. The registration fee is **\$10 per contestant**. The team name (i.e., Martin County Senior Team #1) and team member names will need to be provided. One team and two (2) individuals will be allowed to shoot from each county in both the junior and intermediate divisions. In the senior division each county may have up to three teams (in accordance with the state contest rules). It is the county's responsibility to review and accept participant registration. NO LATE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.

SCHEDULE

Shooting schedules will be e-mailed from the district office by March 28th. The first heat will begin at 8:00 a.m. The Top Gun competition will start following target review of the last heat. The awards program will take place after the Top Gun Contest.

State 4-H Rules and guidelines will be followed at the District Shoot. The 2020 Texas 4-H Roundup Rules and Guidelines will be followed for participation and eligibility. AGE DIVISION

Based on the current 2019-20 4-H year:

- Junior: 3rd, 4th and 5th grades (minimum age of 8 in addition to being in the 3rd grade)
- Intermediate: 6th, 7th and 8th grades
- Senior: 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades (maximum age of 18 as of August 31,2019)

A team may consist of both junior and intermediate 4-Hers, but that team must compete on the intermediate level. Only seniors may constitute a senior team since it is a qualifying contest. The top three senior teams advance to state competition at the Texas 4-H Roundup Indoor Rifle Match in Victoria, Tx, June 8-9, 2020. The top three individuals, if not on a top-3 team, advance to state.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to each participant. The top three teams and individuals in each age division will receive additional recognition. The Top Hand Award recipient will be acknowledged with a belt buckle. Additional prizes may be provided at the discretion of the contest committee.

PROTEST GUIDELINES

- \$25 cash, and must be submitted in writing to a contest chair
- Should be received no later than 30 minutes after the awards program has concluded
- The Protest Committee will consist of the contest committee members and 4-H Specialist
- The committee will meet in private to review and make judgment
- All decisions of the committee will befinal
