#### **Contest Dates**

#### **SCHEDULE**

- The Event Schedule is attached to the end of this document.
- Check in will begin at 7 a.m.
- The First group of events is the Halter Division.

### **Entry Requirements**

- Enter on 4H Online beginning May 12, 2025, at <a href="https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in">https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in</a>
- This is a qualifying event for the State Horse Show. This event is only being held to satisfy your participation requirement.
- The Contest Fee \$5 flat fee for each event entered.

#### **District Deadlines**

- Regular registration ends May 25, 2025
- Late Entry Starts May 26 through June 1, 2025.
- Late Entries will be allowed for an additional \$30 fee,
- Entering new events the day of the show can be made at the registration desk the day of the event for a \$30 fee made by check or money order. No Cash will be accepted.

Junior Grades 3, 4, and 5
Intermediate Grades 6, 7, and 8
Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12

## **Entries Per County**

- Each county may submit as many entries as they like.
- Participation at the District 4-H Horse Show is not required but is encouraged. However, futurity project
  horse must be shown at the district horse show where the project horse is present, to qualify for a futurity
  class at State.

#### **Rules and Guidelines**

• The Texas 4-H Horse Show Contest Rules & Regulations will take precedence.

### **Special Accommodations**

 Any competitor who requires auxiliary aids or special accommodation must contact the district office at least 1 week before the competition or note such needs when registering on 4H Online.

#### **Awards**

• First, second, and third prizes will be awarded to each event.

#### **Protest Guidelines**

- A protest must be filed in writing, accompanied by a \$200 cash fee. It should be received no later than 30 minutes after the class has ended.
- The Protest Committee will consist of the contest committee members and the 4-H Specialist.
- The committee will meet in private to review and make a judgment.
- If the protest is upheld by the appeals committee, the deposit shall be refunded to the protester.
- If the protest is overruled, the deposit shall be forfeited to the horses how fund.
- All decisions of the committee will be final.

### **State Qualifications**

• All classes at the State 4-H Horse Show are open to eligible 4-H youth. Participation at the District 4-H Horse Show is not required but is encouraged; with the exception that a futurity project horse must be shown at the district horse show, district educational clinic, or other equivalent event where the project horse is present, to qualify for a futurity class at State. Participation must be verified by the county extension agent on the State 4-H Horse Show entry form.
